The auditions will consist of one round only, last approximately 20 minutes and will be entirely screened.

The audition must be played in orchestral tuning and will be unaccompanied. The panel will select candidates to move forward to a trial period with the RPO prior to being informed of candidates' identities.

The RPO is unable to reimburse candidates' travel costs. Candidates must have the right to work in the UK. Any international candidates who are unable to travel to the UK for a live audition, should indicate this with their application and, if shortlisted, will be asked to submit a recorded audition.
