Welcome to the Swedish National Orchestra Academy!

As a student at this international master's programme, you...

- » take part in an excellent symphony orchestra along with your fellow students.
- » play standard and new repertoire with world known conductors such as Christian Zacharias, Anja Bihlmaier, Henrik Schaefer, Patrik Ringborg, and Karen Kamensek.
- » work with international soloists and guest teachers.
- » get prepared for a professional career as an orchestra musician by:
 - learning to be a section leader as well as a section member.
 - getting string leader support to improve your leading skills.
 - intonation rehearsals for winds and learning how to form a section.
 - as a pianist, developing your solo playing, chamber music rehearsals, as well as participating in orchestra productions, and working as a répétiteur in musical theatre.
- » study under leading members of the Gothenburg Symphony Orchestra and the Göteborg Opera, who can share knowledge about how to prepare for auditions—and who sit in the panels themselves.
- » get to play mock-auditions regularly with instant constructive feedback from different panels of professional orchestra musicians.
- » can apply for being a soloist with the academy's orchestra.
- » can practise daily in our practicing rooms.
- » play with your teachers and fellow students in smaller ensembles.

EU/EEA citizens are free of fees and students can apply for scholarships for a total of SEK 3,000,000 a year.
The official language for the master's programme is English.
