MASTERCLASSES INTENSIVE INDIVIDUAL WORK

Each student will receive at least **4 individual lessons of 60 minutes**. The public masterclasses are held in the inspiring salons of the **Société de Lecture**, the **Barbier-Mueller Museum**, and the **Conservatoire Populaire de Musique**. All sites are ideally located in the beautiful old city of Geneva.

Three collaborative pianists are available for the lessons when required.

CHAMBER MUSIC

Students get to **collaborate and perform with the faculty** in chamber music. Chamber groups are formed by the academy, including **at least one faculty member in each group**. Students are welcome to suggest repertoire.

GUEST ARTISTS

Baroque violinist **Kati Debretzeni** will give masterclasses and a lecture on the choice of tempi in the **unaccompanied works by J.S. Bach**.

Violist and composer **Garth Knox** will give masterclasses and workshops on interpretation of **contemporary repertoire**.
