“VIRTUOSITE’ PRIZE” 2023

The 20th edition 2023 of International Music Competition “Virtuosite Prize” will take place **online**. In the application form the contestants will specify the link, to access to the videos on Youtube platform.

The application deadline is **10th of September 2023**.

The announcement of the winners will be inserted on website www.agimuspadoval.com not later than **10th of November**.

For the competitors of the sections **piano, piano four hands, string instruments, wind instruments, harp, guitar, accordion, chamber music**, there’s only one 15 minutes audition and a single category: **ages up to 14, no age limit**. The repertoire includes the free choice program which has to express **great virtuosity**.

GENERAL RULES

Art. 1

The Competition is open to musicians of all nationalities and background. The competition purpose is to select musicians with high professional qualities to be introduced in national and international concert circuit. The winners will be included in XXXI International Concert Season 2024 of Padova Music Association AGIMUS and/or in other concert circuits for important concert institutions in italian cities as Rome, Venice, Perugia, Abano Terme.

Art. 2

The application form has to be sent **by e-mail IN DOC or PDF FILE** to the Competition Secretary **not later than 10th of September 2023 (deadline)** at the following address: **padovacompetition@gmail.com**

The application form must be completed with the following documents:

- copy of the Identity Document;
- biography
- photocopy of application fee payment.

The payment has to made only by bank transfer.

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE VIDEO

The contestants will upload the videos on the Yuotube platform.

The **title** of the video must indicate:

name, surname, 20th Padova International Music Competition “Virtuosità Prize” 2023

The **description** of the video must indicate:

music program (composer and pieces), date of performance.

Art. 4

Competitors may enter in “Virtuosità prize” even under the age of 14 years if they consider that their preparation adequate. The competitors who decide to apply in several sections, **against payment of respective application fees** (for example Premio Città di Padova and Soloists and Orchestra) are supposed to perform **a completely different music program for each section.**

SINGLE CATEGORY

Ages up to 14, no age limit: max. 15 minutes length

The music program is free choice.

It is not allowed to overcome the maximum playing time expected. The length indication in the application form must be correct and observe the actual execution time.

For matters not provided in these Regulations the board of Directors has all the competences. The Art Director reserves the right to make changes of various kinds for organizing reasons.

It is not allowed to publish on internet video recordings concerning the competition, without the authorization of the art direction.
