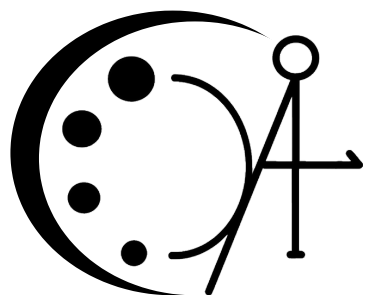

Viola

He was awarded a scholarship by the Herbert von Karajan Foundation to study viola at the Orchestra Academy of the Berliner Philharmoniker.

Michael Gieler plays a viola built by Carlo Antonio Testore (Milan, 1745).

MIRIAM PASTOR BURGOS



Oboe/English horn

Miriam is Concertgebouworkest's cor anglais player, and since 2021 she is Oboe soloist of Orchestre de Paris.

She is a lecturer at the Conservatorium van Amsterdam since 2015.

She was member of the Karajan Academy, the orchestra academy of the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra, Gustav Mahler Youth Orchestra and the European Union Youth Orchestra.

IVAN PODYOMOV



Oboe

Ivan is principal oboist of Concertgebouworkest since 2016. He held the same position with the Bamberg Symphony.

Ivan Podyomov teaches at the Hochschule Luzern school of music.

He won ARD International Music Competition in Munich (in 2011), Geneva Competition (2010), Sony Oboe Competition in Japan (2009) and Prague Spring International Music Competition (2008).

KERSTEN MCCALL



Flute

Kersten McCall is principal flutist of the Concertgebouworkest. With which he appeared as a soloist with works by Mozart, Ligeti, Nono and Wennäkoski.

He teaches at Conservatorium van Amsterdam.

He won first price at the 1997 Kobe International Flute Competition in Japan and third prize at ARD International Music Competition in 2000.

VINCENT CORTVRINT



Flute/piccolo

Before his current position in Concertgebouworkest, Vincent Cortvrint was a member of the Belgian National Orchestra.

In addition, Vincent teaches at Conservatorium van Amsterdam.

He won the 16th National Music Contest of the Crédit Communal de Belgique (1980). As a result, he performed as a soloist with the Flemisch radio Orchestra.

DAVID PERALTA ALEGRE



Violin

He is principal second violinist of the Netherlands Philharmonic Orchestra (2008-). He held the same position in the Netherlands Chamber Orchestra (2006-2008).

He is part of teaching staff at Conservatorium van Amsterdam.

David obtained his soloist's diploma with Maighread McCrann. In 1994 he won the prize for Spanish music 'Joaquín Rodrigo' in Santiago de Compostela.

SYLVIA HUANG



Violin

Sylvia is member of first violin section of Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra (2014-)

She has won prizes in Queen Elisabeth International Competition (2019), Belfius Classics National Musical Competition (2004) and Lions European Musical Competition (2008).

She has been a member of EUYO (2009 - 2010) and the Belgian National Orchestra (2012-13).

PETER BRUNT



Violin

Peter teaches violin at the Royal Conservatoire of The Hague and Conservatorium van Amsterdam.

He was principal second violin of Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra (1984 - 1987)

Peter Brunt won the Netherlands Violin Competition 'Oskar Back' (1981) and other international competitions.
