# Where ?

The Online YSAYE Junior International Music Competition 2022 will take place in the 'TRETEAUX' Hall, Rue de la Chinstrée, 4600 Visé – Belgium only for the jury.

#### When?

February 28 – March 5, 2022.

#### For Who?

The Online YSAYE Junior International Music Competition 2022 is open to young *cellists, pianists* and *violinists*, entering in one of the following age categories :

- Category A: musicians until 12 years old at the time of the competition (born after March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009)
- Category B: From 13 to 18 years old at the time of the competition (born between March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2003 and March 5<sup>th</sup> 2009)

### How?

Each musician (cello, piano, violin) wanting to participate in the Online YSAYE Junior International Music Competition 2022 must send the requested videos and documents to <a href="mailto:ysayecompetition@gmail.com">ysayecompetition@gmail.com</a> before <a href="mailto:December 31st">December 31st</a>, 2021 deadline. The selected musician whose name will be on the website on January 15th must send the semifinal & final videos together at the same address before **February 15th**, 2022.

Other special "Ysaye Junior Prize" (studio recording) of an amount of 4000€ will also be awarded at the end of the competition.

#### The Jury

A jury of worldwide renowned musicians will be present throughout the competition. The names of the jury members will be announced on the website shortly before the start of the competition.

# **Videos**

The preselection video recordings will help the jury to select candidates for the FINAL Round (Cat.A) and SEMIFINAL Round (Cat.B) of the competition.

The names of the chosen participants will be published on the website on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Each piece must be recorded in a single take and without any editing of the audio or video. Cuts between movements of the same piece are not permitted. Participants who do not respect the rules will be disqualified.

The camera must be fixed and placed in front of the musician(s) with clear visibility of the hands and body.

The video recordings should be of good quality, recent and can be done at any location of the participants choosing. Video recordings from concert performances are not permitted.

For all participants and at all levels of the competition, the program must be performed by memory (except for the sonatas with piano accompaniment).

Videos for semifinals and finals must be sent at the same time and address before February 15th, 2022.

#### Rules

Application deadline : **Friday December 31**st, **2021**.

Any application, payment or video arriving after the deadlines (preselection, semifinal, final) will not be accepted.

Each applicant willing to participate in the Online YSAYE Junior International Music Competition 2022 (Cello, Piano and Violin) must send their preselection video and the following documents to: <a href="mailto:ysayecompetition@gmail.com">ysayecompetition@gmail.com</a>

- a) SURNAME, First name, date of birth (YYYY MM DD), nationality, category (cello / piano / violin)
- b) Complete program (preselection, semifinal, final) (NB: only preselection and final for Cat.A)
- c) Video link for preselection
- d) Copy of valid passport or ID Card
- e) Current address & phone number
- f) Proof of payment of registration fees
- g) Artistic picture (vertical)
- h) Short biography (max 500 characters)

The competition is divided into 3 parts: Cello, Piano, Violin. Each of them in 2 age categories: A and B.

The competition is open to cellists, pianists and violinists of all nationalities.

The PRESELECTION by video for all instruments will take place in Belgium, with the preselection jury behind closed doors, between January 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

The ONLINE SEMIFINAL and FINAL Rounds will take place in the "TRETEAUX" Hall of Visé (Rue de la Chinstrée, 4600 Visé – Belgium) from February 28 to March 5, 2022 for the jury (live-stream).

A secretary of the jury will also be present at all events. In case of a tie, a casting vote will be given to the president of the jury.

The organizers will in no way be held responsible for the absence of a member of the jury, whatever the cause. Nevertheless, they will undertake, if possible, to provide a replacement.

The jury's decisions cannot be changed.

Jury may need to cut some performances if necessary, to maintain the allowed time-limit.

Jury members who are parents (up to 3<sup>rd</sup> degree) or teachers of a candidate will not be allowed to vote for the participant.

By entering the contest, the contestant accepts without reservation that the organizers use photos or videos of the contestant for purposes related to the contest.

Video timing must be strictly respected as to maintain a perfect schedule during the live-stream.

The program must be played by memory at all levels of the competition (except for sonatas with piano accompaniment).
