II. Violin – tutti possition

With contract starting 1st May 2022 or by mutual agreement (full-time job, replacement during maternity leave)

Your application must be delivered by **March 06, 2022** to <u>inspektor@mfo.cz</u> and must contain:

- Name, surname, phone number and email address
- CV
- Information, if you need a piano accompanist and what repertoire will you play with accompaniment.

The audition contains of two rounds:

- 1. W. A. Mozart: 1. movement with cadence of one of the concerts D major, A major, G major and J. S. Bach: Sonata and partita of your choice (one part) + orchestral parts from Má vlast (B. Smetana) – which are attached.
- 2. 1. movement with cadence from any concert from the Romantic period or the first half of the 20th century, eventually 1. movement with cadence from concerto of L. van Beethoven + selected orchestral parts which are attached.

Audition will take place on March 16, 2022

At Moravská filharmonie Olomouc, Horní náměstí 23, Olomouc, Czech Republic, Reduta hall.

The exact schedule of the audition will be specified five days before the audition.

The selected candidates will be invited to the audition.

By submitting your personal details in your CV, you agree that Moravian Philharmonic Olomouc will process the information and enter it into orchestra's personal database. Your personal details will not be passed on to a third party without consent. The submission is voluntary; your consent can be withdrawn at any time.

Given the current state of the global coronavirus epidemic, on the day of the audition foreign applicants will be asked to prove a negative PCR test for coronavirus issued by a health organization, which will not be older than 2 days, or vaccination certificate.
